Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV)/Bronchiolitis

Please be aware there are a few children at the center who were recently diagnosed with RSV. This is a common virus that can cause bronchiolitis which is characterized by high fevers and upper respiratory symptoms.

Symptoms

- Cold-like symptoms
- Runny nose or congestion
- Cough
- Difficulty breathing
- Irritability
- Decreased activity
